Hello Vineyard Family,

Following is an updated communication reflective of further clarification from BC Provincial Health Authority.

Effective Nov 30th 2021, all participants attending worship services must wear a mask.* All participants (5 years+) attending worship services, including choirs, must wear a face covering during worship services, including as participants come in to the place of worship and when they leave, until outside.

Masks can be removed for eating and drinking to allow for ceremonial services. Readers and celebrants can remove face coverings if they maintain physically distanced.

Worship can operate at full capacity if all participants are fully vaccinated. Otherwise, services are limited to 50 per cent of seated capacity. As we have already pointed out, in our situation, where vaccination proof is NOT required, our limits will be set at 149 people in the service. Wouldn't that be a great problem to navigate?
